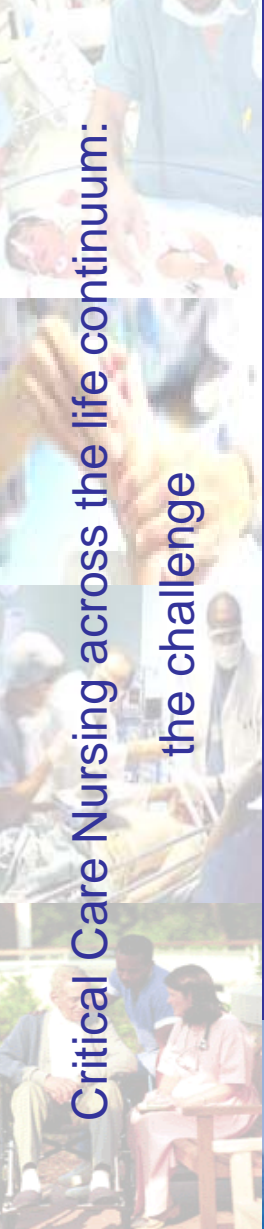

Abstracts submitted from Iran, Malaysia, Japan, Australia = 12

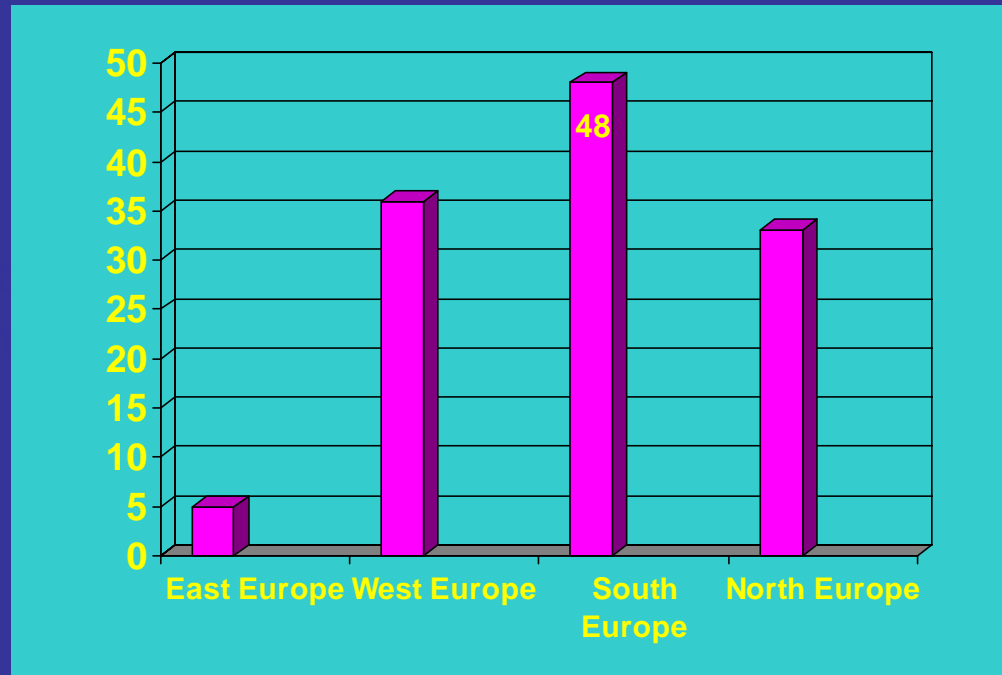

South Europe: France, Italy, Greece, Spain, Turkey

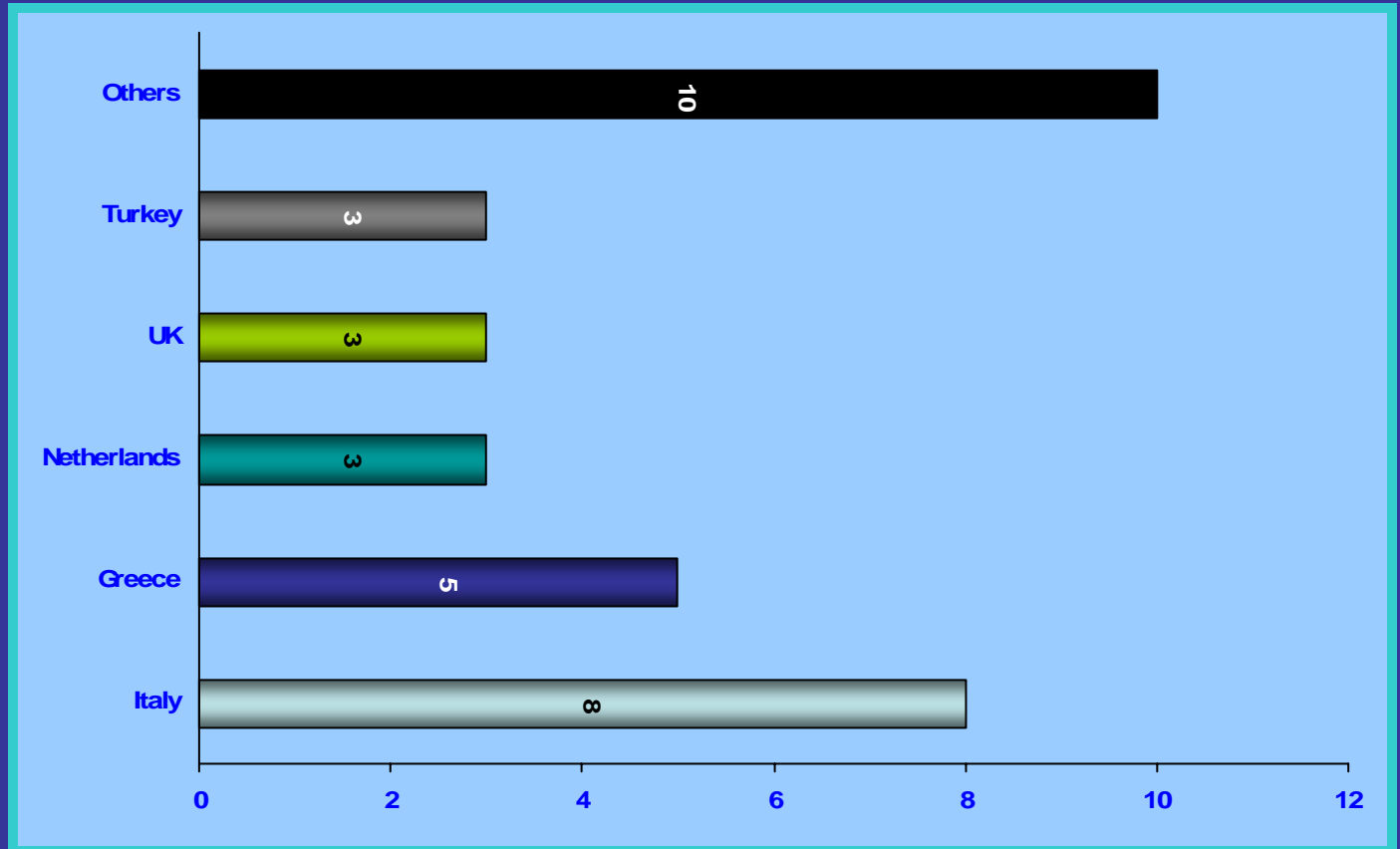
North Europe: Denmark, Finland, Norway, Sweden

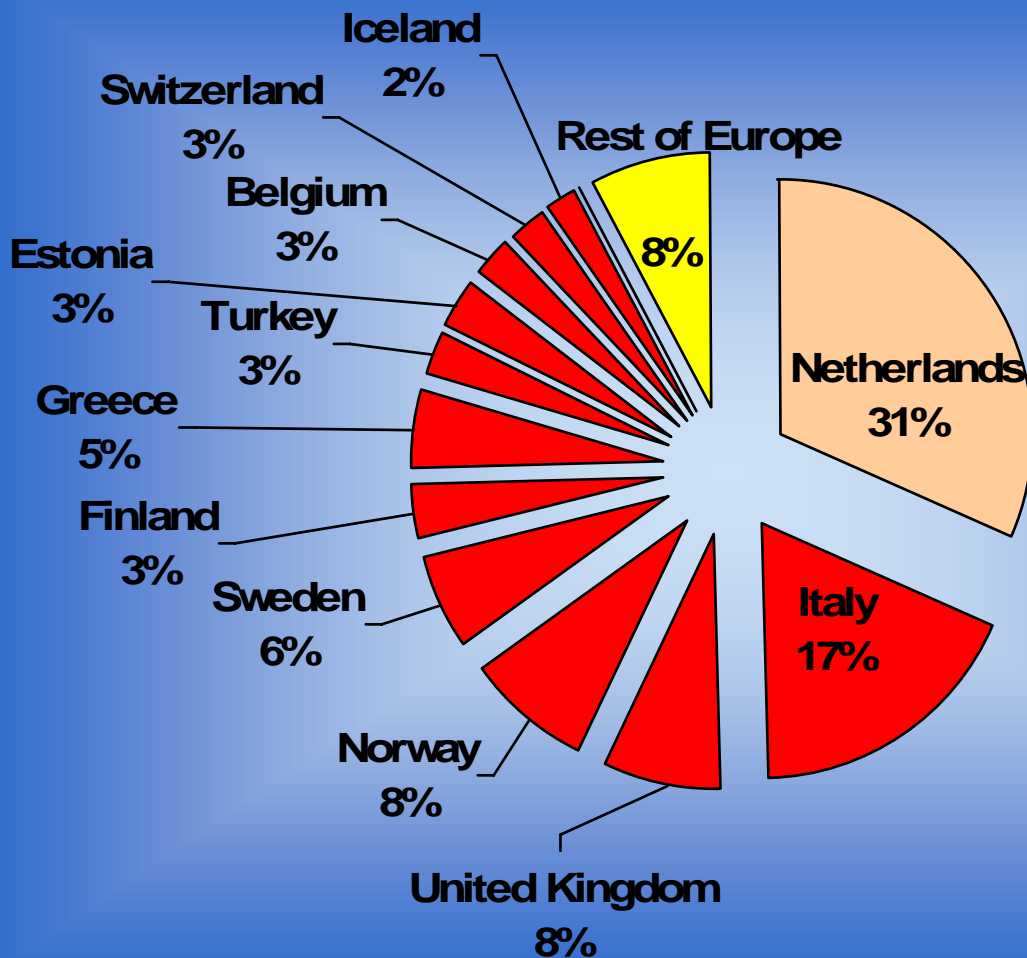




2nd EfCCNa Congress, Amsterdam, 2005

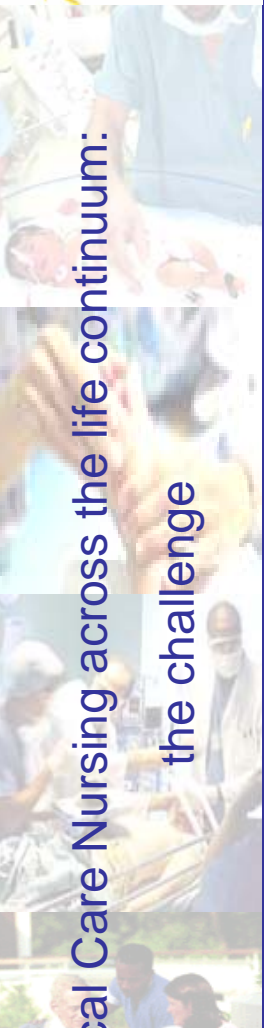
